- ► Started as a volunteer network in 2012/13 secured some project funding including from Office for Students' National Collaborative Outreach Programme (NCOP)— hosted by University of Winchester
- ► Commissioned *Moving on Up* report, 2017 (Neil Harrison) one of the first studies to provide a rounded picture of care leavers in higher education; regularly cited in Access & Participation Plans
- ▶ Became a registered charity and Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) in late 2018
- ► Secured grant funding from Esmee Fairbairn for start-up core costs and project funding from UPP Foundation to develop new Quality Mark
- ► Staff team appointed from late 2019 onwards (2 people each on 0.8fte)
- ▶ Board of Trustees, National Strategy Group, network of regional groups, 90+ organisational members

NNECL mission and role





- ▶ NNECL's distinctive focus is to assist professionals in the development and evaluation of effective practice to support care experienced learners.
- ➤ Our mission is to support, connect and empower our community, with the ultimate goal that more care-experienced people will be able to access and progress through further and higher education into fulfilling careers.
- ► We do this by:
 - celebrating and sharing effective practice;
 - advocating with policymakers and other sector organisations in HE and FE;
 - commissioning and disseminating research;
 - providing our own training, events and guidance materials; and
 - working collaboratively with other cognate charities and sector organisations.



NNECL Quality Mark

- Launched in June 2021 after successful pilot initiatives
- 7 areas, covering whole student lifecycle plus culture/leadership, collaboration and ongoing evaluation
- Proportionate & contextualised, reflecting diversity of institutions across HE/FE and the different policy contexts across the UK
- Awarded for 3 years with mid-point review of action plan







- ▶ First set of awards made in June 2021 to 17 pilot institutions:
- ▶ 13 awards made since June 2021 launch
- ▶ 8 Institutions currently undergoing submission process
